EXPLANATORY NOTES

There are many possible formats for a table of descendants. The present compilation uses a format that keeps siblings together, often on the same page, with the result that the user may have to skip ahead to find descendants. The Table of Contents, and the numbers assigned to each descendant, should make it easy to trace your branch. The plus sign (+) in front of a person's number means there is additional information on his or her family farther down in the list.

The eleven children (second generation) of James Richard Williams are numbered 1 - 11; the twenty-nine grandchildren (third generation), 12 - 40; the seventy-two known great-grandchildren (fourth generation), 41 - 112; the one hundred twenty-nine known great-great grandchildren (fifth generation), 113 - 241. Numerous as the stars indeed! Many of the sixth and a few of the seventh generation are also listed, but are not numbered because the lists are probably incomplete and consecutive numbering would be difficult and constantly changing.

Of the original children of James and Emma, eight survived to adulthood. We have their group picture on page 11, plus individual pictures of Bessie, Willie, Nannie and Nellie, and regret having no individual pictures of Bubba, John Dick, Dolly, or Werner. If good, clear pictures of any of the last four turn up, comparable in quality to the other pictures, we would still like to add them to the archive.

We are all indebted to Jerry Daniel, who made the original compilation in 1995 and added to and carefully checked this one, besides scanning the photographs for the illustrations; to the late Evelyn Clarke Cheely, who provided extensive information to Jerry; to Channing Williams II, Peggy Lowe and others who organized the 2012 reunion that created the occasion for this update; to Rose Clevenger, who reproduced copies of the present update for the reunion; and to everyone who has taken the trouble to submit their own family data to make the compilation as comprehensive as possible.

There are bound to be errors here. The table should be thought of as a draft for correction rather than a definitive compilation. Please submit corrections to the 2012 family reunion email list so each person who has a copy of this document can mark the necessary changes.

WILLIAMS FAMILY BACKGROUND

Richard Jones (or James)¹ Williams (b. Brunswick Co., March, ca. 1834, d. July 28, 1912, bur. Pleasant Grove United Methodist Church cem., Brunswick Co. VA) was the father of our James Richard Williams who married Emma Eugenia Luellen Cheely.

Richard Jones Williams md. "at the house of Mr. William Blanks" in Brunswick Co. VA Aug. 27, 1856, Virginia Ann Blanks (b. Brunswick Co. May 25, 1839, d. July 12, 1895, but July 17, 1885, per VA Vital Statistics Register of Deaths; said to be bur. near her husband), dt. of William J. Blanks and Sarah P. Mitchell. While the census shows varying ages (as is typical), at the time of their marriage in 1856 they gave their ages as 22 and 18. Before his marriage, in the 1850 census for the northern division of Brunswick County, Richard Williams was living in the household of William H. Mitchell, a planter and large landowner. It is not known whether Richard Jones Williams had some family connection to Mitchell or was just working for him.

In the 1860 census for Brunswick Co. VA, Richard and his wife were living in St. Andrews Parish, and Richard was listed as an overseer. Their two-year old son, James Richard Williams, was with them. Bubba, [3] below, said Richard Jones Williams was an overseer on the Tally estate and lived at "Highfields."

Richard Jones Williams served through the entire four years of the Civil War in the Ebenezer Greys (Company E, 56th Virginia Infantry), a Brunswick Co. unit. As recounted in Jerry Daniel's amended version of Dr. William McCaddin Pritchett's *Civil War Soldiers of Brunswick County, Virginia* (hereafter, *CWS*), he was captured at Farmville on April 6, 1865, imprisoned at Point Lookout, MD, and released when the war ended. At the time of his release, he had grey eyes and stood 5' 10 ½", a tall man for the time. (Bubba said he was called "Big Dick," and his son, James Richard Williams, "Little Dick.") He applied for a pension from Nottoway Co. in 1900 and Dinwiddie Co. in 1902, and died in 1916 (tombstone as transcribed in the on line "Cemeteries of Brunswick County, Virginia," says 1912).

¹ His own family Bible, printed in 1857 and in the possession of [11] Aunt Nellie when I copied the data sometime in the 1960s, gives the name as Richard Jones Williams, but sometimes an "a" can look like an "o" (and a "n" like a "m"). Since the present location of the Bible is unknown, the information from it not already given in this background section is transcribed here to prevent its loss. William J. Blanks departed this life January 17, 1883. Virginia Ann daughter of William J. and Sarah P. Blanks was born 25th day May 1839. Richard Wade, son of Willie P. [William Peterson?] and Mary A. Williams was born June 29, 1895. Richard Jones Williams and Virginia Ann Blanks married 27th August 1856. Mrs. M. I. Cheely departed this life in May 1888 [the 1888 is in a different handwriting].

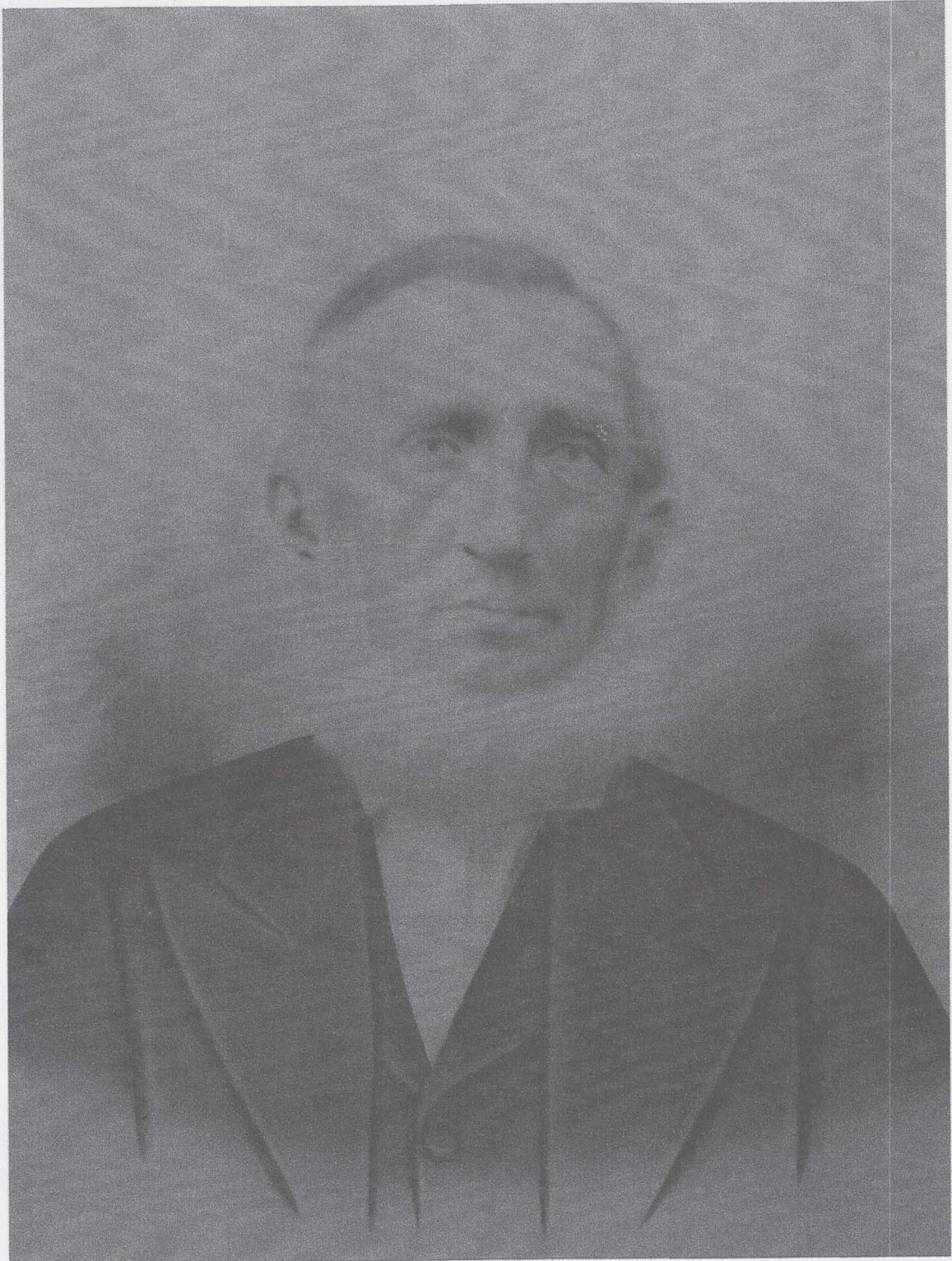
An obituary says he "was respected by young and old, he was a kind hearted man and brave Confederate soldier and Christian gentleman."

Besides James Richard, the eldest (b. April 3, 1858), Richard Jones Williams' other children included: Joseph Henry (b. Sept. 10, 1860, d. before 1870), Virginia Ann Elizabeth (b. Aug. 21, 1865), Mary H. (b. March 26, 1869), William Peterson (b. May 1, 1873), Leodocius Robert "Lee" (b. Dec. 1, 1876), John Early (b. June 19, 1878), Charles (b. April 28, 1882, d. April 1882), and Susan Henry (b. Sept. 12, 1883). These names (except the nickname "Lee") and birth dates are given as transcribed from the Bible referred to in the footnote on the preceding page. A different source gives Feb. 12, 1883, instead of Sept. 12, 1883, for the birth of Susan Henry.

Richard Jones Williams had a sister Sarah H. Williams (b. 1830-35) who lived with him in later years (1870 and 1880 Brunswick censuses). He had a brother Peter Williams (see footnote 3 under [3] Bubba). The parents of Richard Jones Williams, that is, the grandparents of James Richard Williams, were John and Sarah W. Williams (CWS; and 1856 marriage return naming parents).

Bubba, [3] below, gave the present compiler, [57] Bill Wooldridge, the original of this large portrait (facing page) in the early 1960s. Bill was a Civil War buff, and Bubba said the picture was his grandfather, Richard Jones Williams, who was a Civil War veteran -- Bubba knew him well as he did not die until Bubba was about 23. However, in the course of compiling this material, [72] Judieth Richardson furnished a photocopy of a different, smaller picture of what looks like the same man, taken at the same time, seated behind an (unidentified) little boy about four years old with a ruffled collar. Judieth reported that her mother [26] Harriet heard from her own mother, [5] Nannie--who was Bubba's sister--that the bearded man in the small picture was Harriet's granddaddy, James Richard Williams. The little picture is too fuzzy to try to reproduce here.

The photographic technique and clothes in the pictures suggest that they were taken before 1900, when James Richard Williams was 42 or younger. The age of the bearded man in the picture reproduced here seems to be considerably more than 42, so he is probably Richard Jones Williams, as Bubba thought.

CHEELY FAMILY BACKGROUND

Cheely was a London mercantile family. A Thomas Cheely was present at a 1622 meeting of the Virginia Company in London, and some "Mr. Cheale," perhaps the same man and the man subsequently found in Elizabeth City and Lower Norfolk Counties, was in Jamestown in 1624. Thomas Cheely, in Lower Norfolk, said he was 40 in 1637, and 50 in 1640, so was probably born in the 1590s. After the Indian massacre of 1644, Mr. Thomas Cheeley of Elizabeth City County was one of the commanders designated to lead troops against the Indians. Perhaps exaggerating his age, Thomas Cheeley, 65 "and a Decreped man" obtained exemption from taxes in Lower Norfolk County in 1653. He died before 1663, when his land in Lower Norfolk escheated. The escheat may mean he left no direct heirs, but later on there were apparently two men named Joseph Cheely (one dec'd York Co. Feb. 19, 1694; the other dec'd Elizabeth City Co. 1696), The given names "Thomas" and "Joseph" suggest a connection to the Brunswick County family.

There were also people named Ceely or Ceeley, who could belong to the same family, given the irregularity of 17th and 18th century spelling. For example, Thomas Cely of London, merchant, came to Virginia in 1639 or 1659. A Major Thomas Ceely, originally a London merchant, represented Warwick Co. in the House of Burgesses, 1639-59.

The documented line of our own Cheely family begins with Thomas Cheely, who died in Dinwiddie County in 1796 (Dinwiddie Co. Personal Property tax lists, 1796, 1797). He assisted the patriot cause in the Revolution by selling supplies from his farm.

Thomas Cheely of Dinwiddie apparently had a son Joseph Cheely, born about 1760. In 1784 Joseph was serving as an overseer for Richard Taliaferro at Saponey in Dinwiddie Co. By at least 1792 (Robert Lenoir's will in Brunswick Co.), Joseph Cheely had married Winnifred Lenoir of Brunswick Co. She was the daughter of Robert Crawley Lenoir and Winnifred Fisher. The Lenoirs were a French Huguenot family. Joseph Cheely eventually moved to Brunswick Co., perhaps after 1793 when he bought 764 acres there. Joseph died in 1820; Winnifred lived until 1848. Joseph's estate in 1820 was valued at \$9500, a large amount for the time.

Joseph Cheely served in the 14th Virginia regiment in the Continental Line in the Revolutionary War, joining the army while it was still at Valley Forge and serving at White Plains and Middlebrook. His service makes his descendants, who include the descendants of James Richard Williams and Emma Eugenia Cheely, eligible for membership in the DAR and other lineage societies.

Among the children of Joseph Cheely and Winnifred Lenoir was Robert Cheely. Winnifred's 1844 Brunswick County will names her son Robert Cheely (already deceased) and Robert's sons including John H. "Jack" Cheely (b. ca. 1821) who about 1856 married as his second wife Mary E. Slate (b. ca. 1838, d. ca. 1906²) (his first wife had been Louisa S. Johnson). Jack and Mary Cheely were the parents of Emma Eugenia Luellen Cheely (b. Jan. 22, 1860). Jack and Mary Cheely's family appears in the 1860 Brunswick Co. census.

² Because an official death record for Mary Slate Cheely was not found, Aunt Bessie, [1] below, signed an affidavit in connection with research for DAR in 1967: "I lived with my grandmother, Mrs. Mary E. Slate Cheely, about two years shortly before I was married. When I first went to stay with her, she was living in Brunswick County, but moved to Dinwiddie to live with her son, Werner Cheely, taking me with her. I was with her from 1902-1904. I was married in the year 1904. Mary E. Slate Cheely ('Gran' to us) died, to the best of my recollection, in Dinwiddie County, in the year 1906."

James Richard Williams (b. Brunswick Co. VA, April 3, 1858, d. there May 26, 1908, bur. there at Lebanon United Methodist Church cem.), md. Brunswick Co. VA Dec. 22, 1885, **Emma Eugenia Luellen Cheely** (b. there Jan. 22, 1860, d. there Nov. 16, 1930, bur. by husband). He was the son of Richard Jones Williams and Virginia Ann Blanks (p. 5 above). She was the daughter of John H. "Jack" Cheely and Mary E. Slate (pp. 8-9 above).

He was living with his father and mother in the 1860 census of Brunswick County, (St. Andrews Parish) when he was two years old.

His epitaph at Lebanon Church reads:

*He has gone out of sight
Our joy and delight
But O hark to the story
He is resting in glory*

Based on the apparent ages of the sitters and the presence of the whole family except James Richard Williams, Jerry plausibly suggests that the picture was taken shortly after James Richard William's death in 1908, perhaps when everyone was gathered for the funeral. This is a reasonably good copy, but if anyone has the original, we would appreciate the chance to scan it in order to make available a better copy.

- +1. Virginia Elizabeth "Bessie" Williams (b. Brunswick Co. Oct. 5, 1886, d. Petersburg Oct. 26, 1968), md. Brunswick Co. Nov. 24, 1904, Walter Leonard Cheely (b. there June 9, 1874, but tombstone says 1876, d. Petersburg Dec. 9, 1925, bur. Cheely cem., Brunswick Co. off Rt. 642), son of Robert Lenoir Cheely and Mariah A. Bishop. I remember her as Aunt Bessie, a tireless cook and formidable commander of her large household. Breakfast, lunch or dinner -- biscuits were made from scratch at every meal I ever ate at her house, and we prized the homemade pear preserves she sometimes parted with at Christmas. Sandra [49] remembered "when I was a child growing up on Franklin St. in Petersburg, I would walk up Franklin St. with my little puppy, 'Tippy,' cross the major downtown streets, go through the 5 and 10 store, out their back door, to Union St. and up to Grandma's house. We would go often and there was never any worry about safety for us making that trip as children. Sometimes 'Tippy' would make the trip all by herself (she was a small chi/fox terrier), wait at the doors of the 5 and 10 until someone opened the doors for her. I also remember Grandma coming to our house on Franklin St. and we would play Canasta for hours! (She liked to cheat, always drawing more than one card!)"

Oct. 7, 1890 or 1891; dec'd March 2, 1935), dt. of Edward B. Rogers and Ann "Nannie" B. Cheely. Bubba ran a little grocery store close to [4] Grandma Souders' house on Ferndale Ave. so we saw more of him than of the other siblings except perhaps [1] Aunt Bessie. He combined a remarkable memory for names with a real interest in his family, and I took down some of the names in this compilation from him fifty years ago.³ Channing Williams [47] remembered as a small child visiting [4] Willie and playing in Bubba's old store, out of business by then.

³ To preserve the information, I will here set down some of the names that Bubba provided, with the reservation that I could have misheard or misspelled them and that they have not been checked against primary records. Still, Bubba's memory of his family was itself a pretty good primary record! John H. "Jack" Cheely is listed as a farmer in the censuses. Bubba said he drove a freight wagon between Richmond and Petersburg, and that his mother remarried a Mr. Lucy after the death of Jack's father. Jack had the following children with his first wife Louisa S. Johnson: (1) Maria Louisa "Ludie" (b. May 12, 1840, md. Mr. Matthews), (2) Bettie Davis "Bet" (b. March 24, 1842, md. June 13, 1871, John A. Matthews), (3) Pug, (4) Patty (d. May 20, 1910, md. Mr. Smith; their son Carter Smith md. Daisy Rogers, the sister of Bubba's wife Edna Rogers), (5) Johnny, (6) Willie. Mr. Alvin Smith of Warfield, VA, had a Bible, Bubba said, with information on the Matthews family; presumably the Bible was the source of the 1840 and 1842 birth dates.

Jack Cheely and his second wife Mary Slate had children: (1) Marcus L., remembered as Uncle Mark, but his full name was Marquis Lafayette Cheely, b. March 22, 1869, d. Dec. 23, 1934, had daughter Lora or Lona b. Nov. 29, 1893, d. July 2, 1944, who md. Mr. Jernigan; (2) Jefferson, md. Minnie Blanks and had children Frances and Jeff Jr.; (3) Robert F. or Robert Lee, md. Linda Hawks and had children Monroe, Charlie, Rufus, Crawley, Rux (Rex? Rox?), Otis, Yarborough, Lizzie, Myrt (Myrtle?), Delia, Linda, and Sadie; (4) Werner md. Jennie Echols; (5) Dorothy "Dollie" md. Richard Howerton and had children Jessie, Jack, Gurt or Burt, Rennie, Anna Mae who md. Arthur Jones, Geneva; (6) Beula md. Willie Bishop and had children Grace and Levy; (7) Emma, who is the subject of this pamphlet; (8) Josephine, b. July 17, 1871, d. Oct. 17, 1947, md. Jim Cheely (Bob Cheely's son) and had children Guy, Ella Mae who md. Josephine Sciotto, Kate who had the remarkable total of 18 children, and Harper who md. Gracelle Smith, sister of Alvin Smith; (9) one child who died in infancy.

Robert L. "Bob" Cheely, Jack's brother, had children (1) Anna who md. Sandy Bishop, (2) Winnie, (3) Nannie who md. Mr. Rodgers and had Daisy (md. Carter Smith) and Edna (md. Bubba), (4) Julia, (5) Lelia, (6) Mattie, (7) Jim who md. Jack Cheely's daughter Josephine, (8) Thomas [who md. Nora ---], (9) Bob who died, and (10) Walter who md. [1. Bessie Williams].

Richard Jones Williams (b. ca. 1834) had a brother Peter Williams. This Peter Williams had children (1) Mollie who md. Pete Blanks, (2) Mattie, (3) Maggie, (4) Eddie, (5) Charlie, (6) Hattie, (7) Lelia who md. Mr. Talley and had son Meade, and (8) Minnie, the youngest, who married "Uncle Jeff" (our Emma's brother) and was the mother of Frances and Jeff

- +4. Willie Daily Williams (b. June 13, 1891, d. Durham, NC, Feb. 12, 1949, bur. Blandford cem., Petersburg) md. May 14, 1911 Charles Lincoln Souders (b. Jan. 31, 1865, d. Sept. 10, 1929, bur. Lebanon United Methodist Church, Brunswick Co.), son of William James Souders and Eliza Johnson. She won a copy of *Pilgrim's Progress*, which we (WCW) still have, as the best student in her one-room Brunswick County school. She married a much older man from the North (his middle name was Lincoln!) who worked in the box factory in Kress, a place in Brunswick County that no longer exists. Widowed while still young, she sold foundation garments -- corsets, [46] Peggy Lowe remembered -- from door to door during the Depression and made enough to send her daughter, my mother, to college, not common at the time, and eventually to buy a house. Peggy recalled that "we used to go to her house on Saturday morning because she would go down to the little store on her block [Bubba's?] and get us donuts. Then she would let us dip them in her coffee cup. That was a great treat to us because with five kids in the family, we never had donuts. Also Aunt Willie gave my mom a set of silver for Christmas one year, a complete setting for each of us and a smaller one for Channing who was the baby." As a traveling salesperson, she "was on the road from Petersburg to Richmond and other places a lot. She kept an autograph book in her glove compartment and when she would pick up servicemen who were hitching a ride, she would have them sign her book. She dearly loved helping the soldiers and sailors." Channing Williams [47] himself remembered "staying overnight with 'Aunt Willie' . . . what has always stuck in my mind was the fact that she served us cookies for breakfast and she had a picture on her wall of one of the prettiest ladies, in a wedding dress, that I had ever seen. The picture was of [18] Easter," her daughter. When Willie died, Easter reflected on her sales career: "After the first call, her customers loved to see her coming. She must have been mother-confessor to 10,000 people all over the state. How many life stories must have spilled over to her, how many hearts lightened by her quick sympathy and then her flash of fun and shared laughter." While my father was overseas, we lived with her at 1406 Ferndale Avenue in Petersburg for a few months in 1945, possibly into 1946. She crocheted (Christmas 1948) a gorgeous multicolored afghan for me that I still have.

- +5. Mary Ann "Nannie" Williams (b. near Kress, Brunswick Co., Jan. 22, 1893, d. Petersburg, March 29, 1980, bur. at Southlawn Mem. Park there), perhaps eloped, md. at Roanoke Hotel, Halifax Co. NC Nov. 27, 1912, William Bernard (went by Bernard) Traylor Sr. (b. Dinwiddie Co., Jan. 14, 1890, d. Petersburg Oct. 16, 1959, bur. near wife), son of Wesley Traylor and Ida Washer. On his World War I draft registration, he said that he was an engineer for the F. J. Kress box company in Kress, and that he was born in Dinwiddie Co. Subsequently he worked as an auto mechanic, moved to Petersburg about 1929, and worked there for the Brown and Williamson Tobacco Company. They lived on Ferndale Ave. Nannie's grand-daughter [72] Judy recalled, "Grandma was a devoted life-long member of Memorial Methodist Church on Washington St., Petersburg. She was a seamstress for Stuart Keith Manufacturing of Petersburg for 25 years. She was fondly remembered by [26] Mama for making clothes for the entire family including the boys and her husband. Mama was particularly proud of the beautiful clothes Grandma created for her out of [11] Aunt Nellie's hand-me-downs. Additionally. . . , Nannie was an excellent cook, with her 'Snowball pudding' being the best ever. I am sure all of the grandchildren, as well as any Christmas visitor, will remember Grandma's huge Christmas stocking that we could dig in for one gift! There are many special memories of a kind and loving Grandma. I particularly loved sleeping in her feather bed and listening to her quietly mumble her bedtime prayers on her knees."

- +7. Dorothy Jane "Dolly" Williams (b. April 17, 1897, d. Richmond April 30, 1967, bur. there), md. 1916 William Eugene "Deanie" Peters (b. NC Sept. 16, 1892, d. Richmond, Oct. 15, 1971, bur. there).
- +8. Werner Jefferson Williams Sr. (b. near Kress, Brunswick Co., Sept. 28, 1899, d. Brunswick Co. or Richmond, July 25 or 28, 1972, bur.
